Well, thanks to your prayers and generosity, we are finishing up the first half of 2023 with a strong showing of how much the Lord loves all of us, how much He wants to bless us, and how He wants to use each of us to bring those blessings to others. Thank you for praying about the Joshua Tuck Memorial Scholarship Fund. We thank God that friends of the ministry supplied the rest of \$2,000 that we needed to renew the grants to Brother Zaldy Velasquez and Sister Camille Neves for the 2023-2024 college semesters. After much prayer and learning more about how the church in Philippines struggles to take care of its Bible college students, I have decided to increase the amount of our scholarships from \$500 to \$750 per student per semester. This means that it is necessary to extend our fundraiser for our scholarship fund until the Lord provides another \$1,000 for this year's project. We have enough money already to cover the first semester. Please pray that we would raise the remaining \$1,000 before the end of the year. There is also a third student who will start college this year and needs help if possible.

There are other exciting things happening in Philippines. We prayed for \$750 expenses to hold Vacation Bible School in the main church for 250 children and \$500 expenses for a second VBS in one of the villages where Pastor Aris is trying to start a daughter church. \$300 was given last month. Praise God, He used Sewell Valley Baptist Church and Big Sewell Baptist church to provide the remaining \$950 needed for both events. Icing on the cake was when we received \$40 to buy nice Bibles for Pastor Aris to present to four adults who were recently baptized and added to the church. We are also thankful that \$500 was given to partition off a room in the church fellowship building where Brother Zaldy can stay when he is not away at school. Brother Zaldy, Sister Camille, and the third student needing financial help all have key roles in the present and future ministry of Pastor Aris' church.



All I can say about Ukraine is "WOW!" "WOW", that the country remains united in standing up to its aggressor, and "WOW" that the Lord continues to bless it in amazing ways. Thank you for praying about the project to buy a house for Ivan, the pastor of Source of Life Church. Praise God, \$8,500 was given this month to make the purchase and \$2,000 was given for repairs inside. I am especially proud that my home church, Sewell Valley Baptist Church, gave \$7,500 to complete the purchase. Also, the Lord again provided \$3,000 to support relief workers in Salvation Church, \$1,678 to fund relief work done by Born Again Church, and \$2,000 to cover relief expenses of Cross of Christ Church. At least \$6,200/month is needed to continue the work of these three churches. Since the beginning of this year, most of this amount has been donated by members of the New Covenant Bible Church in Saint Charles, Illinois. Please pray that the Lord will continue to bless Ukraine. The situation there is terrible, but it is an enormous opportunity for us to be used by the Lord to show His mercy and grace. I am so thankful that God is allowing me and our ministry to take part in these events of our time.

On a lighter note, all work and no play make Frank a dull boy. We just finished the third annual Cruzfest- a threeday reunion of my wife's side of the family. It was conceived, and is hosted, by my daughter, Maryanne, and her husband BJ Grimmett. My wife, Leonora, also makes an intense effort each year. Our favorite activity- eating Filipino food- was often interrupted by horse-back riding, soccer games, fire dancing, target practice, running remote-controlled cars, and nightly bingo games. Please pray concerning me, my family, our ministry, our country, and the rising ungodliness all over the world- a world that increasingly needs the Lord Jesus Christ. Franklin Juck gr.
