We are involved in helping so many people that I forget many of the projects we completed earlier in the year. Our Board members and I are excited about being used by the Lord as much as possible in 2024. Of course, your continued financial support and prayers are what will make that possible. We thank the Lord for Lansing Baptist Church. They gave \$500 to sponsor 5 days of VBS in India. Three days were held at the Baca Valley Church and two days at one of the local satellite churches. The students were fed breakfast and lunch daily, studied English and the Bible, and received certificates and small gifts. Please continue to pray for Pastor Joseph, his family, the ministry in Andhra Pradesh, and a visa for me to visit again soon.

Thank you for praying for Pastor Aris in Philippines. The church there celebrated its 5th anniversary this month. We were able to help with the celebration and with construction of a fence across the front of the facility. We also thank Sewell Valley Baptist Church for again giving \$240 to sponsor another month of children's feeding stations in Philippines. Lord willing, Pastor Aris will visit us in USA in July for three months. There is a possibility that his wife, Connie, will be allowed to come with him. Before that, at the end of June, Brother Aris is planning to hold his annual VBS (in two parts, like last year). He is expecting 250 students at the main church and then 100 students in San Fabian where he is starting a daughter church. \$4 is needed for expenses of each child. **Please continue to pray** for these needs: \$1000 for VBS #1, \$400 for VBS #2, plane tickets for Brother Aris and his wife, \$1500 to construct fence on two sides of the church property, \$700 to install soffit on the parsonage, and \$7000 to buy a used van for the youth ministry. I know- WOW- that is a lot! I am a witness, though- for as long as I have known him, Aris Alfonso has not been afraid to trust God extensively, and the Lord has provided extensively (including his current church building and parsonage).

Please continue to pray for Israel and Ukraine. We praise God that \$6400 was again sent this month to Ukraine for humanitarian aid. We are not sure how long we can keep on helping at this level. Much, much, much prayer is needed on Ukraine's behalf. Starting on June 15, a Peace Summit will be held in Switzerland. More than 80 countries are planning to attend. President Zelensky has prepared a short video (6 minutes) where he talks about destruction in Ukraine and the need for such a summit. He is hoping that Russia will pay more attention to this large group of leaders than it has to Ukraine alone. President Zelensky is particularly asking the USA and China to get involved. You can watch the video on youtube ToTheLeaders YT UkrSubs (youtube.com). I think you will be interested. In any case, please pray for this summit.
